

Workforce Development Capital Grant Program

\$35 Million for Grants

- Awards amounts range from \$100,000- \$3 million
- ESD will provide up to 50% of total project cost
- Projects must commence within 6 months of award

Eligible Use of Funds

- Purchase/installation of machinery/equipment
- Purchase/installation of furniture/fixtures
- Renovations of existing building
- New construction/expansion of existing building
- Acquisition of land
- Soft costs of up to 15% of total project



Pay For Performance Program

\$115 Million for Pay for Performance Program

- Two Program Tracks
- Focused on High Quality, In-Demand Jobs
- Resource for training programs offering industry-recognized credentials & certificates


Operating Grants

Capacity-Building Awards



Program Objectives

- Serving historically marginalized communities by removing barriers to employment
- Support opportunities for un/underemployed & underrepresented workers
- Making sure there are business and community partnerships, so trainees have access to good jobs





Operating Grants

- Grant funding can be used for programmatic expenses related to a new program, or expanding an existing program
- ESD will provide up to 75% of total project cost

Minimum level of assistance:	\$50,000
Maximum level of assistance:	\$1,000,000

Capacity-Building Awards

- Achievement-based awards to expand programs' capacity
- Awards range from \$1,500-\$4,000 per trainee placed in a good job
- Data and metrics driven award

Award Eligibility

Amount of award determination will be based on the following:

- Extent of wrap-around services
- Need of the population served
- Placement in good jobs
